## 'Dahlia' Tops Out at 20 Storeys in Manhattan

[Dahlia](#), a 20-storey luxury residential building in [Manhattan](#)'s Upper West Side, has reached its final structural height. [United Management](#) and [Reuveni Real Estate](#) celebrated the feat with a traditional topping off ceremony held at the site—located at 212 West 95th Street—where guests were taken on a tour and signed the last steel beam that was then raised and put into position at the top of the tower.

[CetraRuddy Architecture](#) is the design architect and interior designer, with [RKTB Architects](#) as the architect of record and [JRM](#) as the construction manager of the project. Located between Broadway and Amsterdam Avenue, Dahlia will contain 38 two- to four-bedroom residences, including two penthouses and select floor plans with private outdoor spaces. A number of amenities are also on tap for residents, including a music room, games room, lounge, children's play area, fitness room, yoga studio and a 5,100-square-foot elevated outdoor park.

"Dahlia's symbolic topping off marks a significant milestone for the Upper West Side. After over a decade of stagnant new construction along the Broadway corridor north of West 86th Street, the neighbourhood is now experiencing the long-awaited arrival of modern new development product

with Dahlia at the helm," said Shlomi Reuveni, President and CEO of Reuveni Real Estate. "We have so far received overwhelmingly positive response and a strong demand from Upper West Side residents desperately seeking new condominium developments at more attractive price levels."
